supplies

- Tray Set of 3-Small, medium and large
- American Acrylic-
 - Indian Turquoise
 - Burnt Umber
 - Milk Chocolate
- Folk Art Acrylic
 - Teddy Bear Brown
- Coffee Cup Fabric Fat Quarter
- #3 Round Brush and 1" Flat Brush
- Ultra Seal 4 oz
- Envirotex 4 oz
- Mixing/Measuring Cup
- Glossy Finishing Spray
- Wood Filler
- Sand Paper
- Fabric Tape Ruler



Directions:

1. Sand all edges and wipe clean with a damp paper towel. Fill any gaps or dents with wood filler. Let dry. Sand again and wipe clean.
2. Paint top, bottom, and inside edge of the handle with Indian Turquoise using the round brush. Do this step in each of the trays. Let dry. Paint the inside, outside, and bottom of each tray with two coats of paint. Small tray: Teddy Bear Brown, Medium Tray: Milk Chocolate, Large Tray: Burnt Umber.
3. Seal all edges of the tray using the glossy finishing spray.
4. Cut fabric to fit each tray by measuring the inside bottom with a fabric tape ruler. Apply a tick coat of Ultra Seal with a brush and carefully place fabric on glue. Let dry.

5. Apply three more coats of Ultra Seal, let dry between each coat making sure to seal the edges.
6. Follow manufacture instructions that come with the box of Envirotex. Mix and pour on Envirotex. Mix 2 oz (1 oz of each bottle) for small tray. Mix 3 oz (1-1/2 oz of each bottle) for medium and large tray. Mix and pour one tray at a time and be sure to get out all of the bubbles. Remember that Envirotex takes 48-72 hours to dry, so put your tray where they won't get dirty.
