

GIANT clothespin

Difficulty Rating- Easy Medium Difficult

supplies:

- Large wood clothespin
- Mod Podge
- Patterned papers of your choice
- Acrylic paint or wood stain
- Embellishments of your choice
- Scissors or paper trimmer
- Heavy duty magnet (optional)

directions:

1. Take apart wooden clothespin.
(This is to insure no paint gets on the metal center of clothespin)
2. Paint or stain the sides of the wooden clothespin. Allow to dry.
3. Select paper for front and inside of clothespin. Place clothespin on paper and trace around outside. Cut paper along lines using scissors or a paper trimmer. Make sure to cut out paper where the metal piece will be.
4. Use Mod Podge to glue your cut pieces of paper onto the clothespin. Let dry.
5. Add embellishments to your piece. Stickers and chipboard shapes work great.
6. Put metal center back in clothespin.
7. Glue heavy duty magnet to back of clothes pin to make your clothespin into a note or picture holder for your refrigerator. (optional)
