

## supplies

- Wood or chipboard letters
- Sheet moss
- Tacky glue
- Ribbon
- Flowers
- Scissors
- Hot glue gun

## Directions:

1. Adhere sheet moss to letters using tacky glue. Cover only a small area with glue at a time. This ensures that the glue will not dry before you can cover it with moss.
  2. Use scissors to trim the moss around the edges of the letter.
  3. To hang letters: hot glue 18 inch pieces of ribbon on the back in center.
  4. Use hot glue to adhere flowers of your choice to front of letters. Use as many or as few as you like.
  5. Make bows with remaining ribbon and place at top (optional).
- \* Options: There are many directions you can go with this project. Spell out a word, a name, or a person's initials. This can be a great idea for a wedding decoration.
