

12x12 Dry Erase Board

Difficulty Rating- Easy Medium Difficult

supplies

- 1 - 12"x12" craft frame
- 1 - 12"x12" sheet of dry erase board
- 1 - 12"x12" Wild Saffron paper
- K&Co. Wild Saffron Swirl rub-ons
- Ceramcoat paint
 - Burnt Umber
 - Lt. Foliage (green)
- double-sided tape



Directions:

1. Start by removing glass from the frame. Then paint frame with Lt. Foliage Green.
2. Cut paper into 1-3/4" x 12" strips. Piece strips together so you have four 15" long strips. (Easy to piece with striped paper.)
3. Adhere 2 of the 15" strips to the front of the frame, across from each other.
4. With other two strips: fold corners over to create angle. Cut along fold to create mitered edge. Adhere to front of frame.
5. Using Burnt Umber paint, dry brush edges of frame.
6. Insert dry erase board sheet in frame. Apply desired rub-ons to each corner.
