

Rag Time **BABY QUILT**

Difficulty Rating- Easy Medium Difficult

Supplies:

- 12 - 1/2 yard pieces of assorted flannels or a total of 6 yards of flannel
- 1 2/3 yards of cotton batting (do not wash the fabrics)

Directions:

1. Cut flannels in 9" squares and cut batting into 7" squares.



2. To make the "Fabric Sandwiches": Lay 1 piece of flannel right side of fabric facing down. Put a piece of the batting on top, directly in the center. Put a matching piece of flannel on top, facing up. Sew an X through the square to secure the layers together.

3. When you have all the squares put together, lay the blocks out in the pattern desired 6 blocks across and 8 blocks down.

4. Sew the blocks together in rows with all of the edges toward the front of the quilt. Use a 1 inch seam allowance.

5. After the blocks have been sewn together in rows, sew the rows together making sure that your edges are all towards the front of the quilt.

6. Sew a 1 inch seam all the way around the quilt to secure the edges.

7. Clip the seam allowance close to but not through the stitching.

8. Wash and dry the quilt. We suggest going to a launder mat as it is a very messy process.
